Board of Selectmen – Special Meeting Thursday, May 10, 2018 5:00 p.m.

- 1. Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. Present were Kurt Youland, Chairman, Angelo Terreri, Vice Chairman, Selectmen Warren Hood, Steve Maheu and Kevin Nichols, Town Manager Kurt Schaub, and resident Mike Gotto.
- 2. Adjustments to the Agenda:** There were no adjustments to the Agenda.
- 3. Town Meeting Warrant:** The revised Town Meeting Warrant was reviewed. The changes in the version under consideration and the original copy that appears in the Town Report involve ordinance amendments as reviewed and recommended by the Planning Board. Motion and second to approve the Warrant as presented, and to recommend adoption of the ordinance amendments, unanimous approval. The revised Warrant was signed and will be posted on Friday, May 11, in accordance with the statutory requirement.
- 4. Paving and Construction Carryover Quote:** The paving quote from Spencer Paving was reviewed. Spencer has held its price to put down the town's cold mix asphalt at \$4,000 per day for several years, and proposes an increase of \$250 per day for the same work and terms. The quote references the rising cost of diesel fuel to run the equipment, and the increased cost of labor. All States Materials, which manufactures the town's cold mix, has held its price, but their arrangement allows for the final price to vary, based on the market price of liquid asphalt as reported on the Maine Department of Transportation website. Motion and second to accept the Spencer quote, unanimous approval.
- 5. AVCOG Planner Invoice:** AVCOG's invoice for Planner Services for the month of March was reviewed. The bill is for \$2,425, is mainly for ordinance amendment services, and a comparable invoice for the month of April is expected. Mr. Schaub noted this will substantially exceed the Planning Board's budget for Planner Services and result in an overdraft. Motion, second and unanimous approval to hold the invoice for now and revisit when the bill for April services arrives.
- 6. Adjournment:** Motion, second and unanimous approval to adjourn the meeting at 6:00 p.m.
