

**BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES**  
**MONDAY, DECEMBER 1, 2014**  
**6:30PM**

1. **Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance:** Mr. Youland called the meeting to order at 6:30pm and the Pledge of Allegiance was said. Present: Mr. Ralph Caldwell, Mr. Kurt Youland, Mr. Richard Keene, Mr. Angelo Terreri, Mr. Kurt Schaub, Mr. John Moultrie, and Mr. Toby Martin. Absent: Mr. Dennis Richardson
2. **Adjustments to the Agenda:** Add five abatements to the agenda.
3. **Public Works:** Mr. Moultrie would like permission to seek out proposals for purchasing a steam cleaner/culvert-thawing machine. Current machine's heating system has failed. Mr. Moultrie will obtain some pricing and bring back to the Board.
4. **Rescue Chief Report:** Currently not charging for no-transport of patients. Mr. Schaub and Mr. Martin are working on putting together a policy on billing no-transport patients and will present to Board at a later date.
5. **Old Business: 5-1: Snell Hill Road Traffic Signal:** Following the November 17<sup>th</sup> meeting Mr. Schaub reviewed the Traffic Signal Agreement with the Department of Transportation, and according to the agreement the town "shall make no operational changes or modifications to the traffic signal without the express written approval of the Department of Transportation". Mr. Schaub contacted DOT and stated that the town would like to change the light to a flashing mode during off hours. The first response was that they are unwilling to go to a flashing light, as that has been shown to increase accidents, and provided the sensors are functioning properly, there is no reason for the light to change unless the sensors are tripped. To be certain it is functioning properly, tested the light of this past Tuesday afternoon. Mr. Schaub and Mr. Moultrie were present for the test and it appears all is working as should. **5-2: SAD 52 Salt Sand/Sidewalk Plowing:** At issue is the unwritten agreement that the town will provide the district with salt/sand in exchange for SAD52 clearing the sidewalk along Turner Center Road that was installed by the state. Mr. Moultrie and Mr. Schaub will meet with the school to see if they can negotiate a deal where as SAD52 gives the town a dollar figure for taking care of the sidewalks and the town will supply SAD52 with that amount of salt/sand and anything above that price would have to be purchased from the town. Mr. Moultrie and Mr. Schaub will bring it back to the Board.
6. **Town Manager's Report: 6-1: Christmas Tree Lighting:** Plans are complete for the Christmas Tree Lighting and Santa's arrival. Murray Oil and Propane removed the old lights and hung the new red lights. Dan Dimambro (Have Records, Will Travel) will provide an outdoor sound system and Christmas music will be playing outdoors as folks arrive. Hornets in Harmony, who have prepared four songs. Business providing treats are: Androscoggin Bank, Community Credit Union, Food City, Hannaford, Paris Farmers

Union and Ricker Hill Orchards. **6-2: Tri-Town Meeting:** December 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm here at Turner Town Office.
