Town of Turner Bid Notice Heating Oil/Propane (LPG)

The Town of Turner requests bids for #2 Heating Oil and Propane (LPG) for the 2026-27 winter season. The Town uses approximately **2,900 gallons of heating oil** and **10,450 gallons of propane** at the town-owned facilities listed below, each of which requires automatic delivery. Bids are to be emailed or hand delivered to the Town Office by 2:00 p.m. on Monday, July 20. The bid will be awarded during the regular Board of Selectmen meeting at 6:00 that evening. This bid shall cover deliveries made between the date of award and May 31, 2027. Be advised that the award may be split – one vendor for oil and a different vendor for propane.

The town is looking for both a fixed price and variable pricing. Bids should be in two parts, and detail all applicable discounts, including prompt payment, and any cost associated with supplying a propane storage tank at the specified locations. They are:

1. Your company's fixed, delivered, price per gallon; and
2. A variable price consisting of the supplier's rack price plus a fixed margin. For this bid, please provide the price that would be charged the town as of 12:00 noon on Friday, July 17, including documentation from your supplier to support the pricing example, which will remain confidential.
